Containment for sanding, scraping, and painting must comply with the G.E.P.A. Guam Clean Air/Clean Water Act with the approval by the PAG Safety Division. (Containment curtains must be installed to collect debris from operations of: sanding, scraping and painting, etc. Prior to any work performed, tarp must be laid and a berm (sandbag) must be erected surrounding the vessel and erected on top of tarp to collect debris preventing discharge into the US waterways.

**NOTE: A berm of sand bags must be erected along the entire edges of tarp surrounding the work site. This is to help prevent work debris run-off into the ocean.

SAMPLE

Basic Scope of Work for Dry Docking

(Sample of Description)

- >Lay tarp down.
- >Lay sandbag on top of tarp.
- >Set up jack stands for placement of vessel/boat.
- >Set up tarp around the boat to prevent any airborne particles from escaping while:
- >Pressure wash the hull using water blaster (3.000 psi).
- >Sand the hull using 7" grinders & sand paper (60 grit). Sanding suits & full-face respirators will be used while sanding.
- >Wipe down with acetone.
- >Wash down the hull with water.
- >Prep and paint using Amron #ABC#3 Tin Free antifouling paint 43% copper will be rolled on.
- >Cure Time.
- >Remove Tarp from around the boat.
- >Remove Boat from jack & set back in water.
- >Remove Tarp and sandbags from ground and dispose of properly.
- >Properly dispose of all other debris.
