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### QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES FOR CFS BUILDING PAINTING BID (IFB-PAG-CIP-022-007)

#### Questions submitted by Shibby, Inc.:

 Please confirm if the exposed pipelines like sprinklers, plumbing, electrical conduits, and downspouts are included in the scope of work.

**Response:** Sprinklers and plumbing pipelines are not included. However, downspouts, electrical conduits, and clamps on the walls should be painted.

2. Please provide construction duration from the date of Notice to Proceed.

**Response:** A total of One hundred eighty (180) calendar days from the project commencement date of the NTP (Notice to Proceed).

3. Please provide a warranty period for the roof waterproofing.

**Response:** A total of five (5) years warranty for the roof coating and one (1) year warranty period for all other surfaces. The warranty period commences from the date of the final closed-out report submitted and signed.

4. Please confirm if Fabric Mesh is required on roof waterproofing

Response: No, it is not required.

 Please confirm if the contractor is allowed to use power and water at the Jobsite at no additional cost. This will save the contractors time on processing the permit and application for water and power connection.

Response: Regarding the use of power on the job site, the contractor will be responsible for providing on-site generators of sufficient capacity. Depending on the quantity of water needed for the project, the Port Facility will install a separate water meter for the contractor's use. The current water rate per cubic meter is provided at \$32.73 per 1000 Gallon. Refer to Amendment No. 2 – Revised Bid Schedule Line Item No. 8.

### Questions submitted by Engineer Surface Solutions:

 Per the below Bid Schedule, items 4 and 5 state two (2) coats of primer paint. But the product manufacturer for the silicone roof coating and exterior paint recommends only one (1) coat of primer paint. Please advise if items 4 and 5 will be priced with 2 coats of primer paint.

Response: Refer to Amendment No. 2 – Revised Bid Schedule line items 4 and 5.

2. It was mentioned during the site visit that there is an existing roof coating and bidders can request photos of the roof. So, can we please request the latest photos of the roof to help us





understand its actual condition? In the bid schedule there is no line item for removal of existing coating, please clarify also.


**Response:** Yes. Refer to Addendum No.1 attachment(s). Do not remove existing roof coating, unless they are required in some isolated areas only.

3. Item 6 states that signage and fasteners are stainless steel, please clarify whether they are Type 316 SS or Type 304 SS.

4. Per the photos below, some rough surfaces can be found both on the interior and exterior of the building. Please advise if we will include patching and grinding in our proposal and in what line item it will be inserted.







Response: Refer to Amendment No. 2 – Revised Bid Schedule Line item 7. Please provide plastering unit cost per square foot.

5. While we are waiting for our vendor's pricing and processing of our bid bond, we would like to request a two (2) week time extension on the bid submission.

### **QUESTION SUBMITTED BY ISLA SYSTEMS:**

1. This is Jon Davis with Isla Coating and Roofing Supply, I was requesting as-built drawings and the specs for the CFS building project. I have the scope of work but was wondering if there were specs for this job so we can make the most accurate bid possible.

**Response:** The awarded vendor will be evaluated based on the lowest, most responsive, and most responsible bidder. The PAG Engineering will review and approve the bid submittal based on the Bid Schedule and Bid Submittals.

### QUESTION'S SUBMITTED BY General Pacific Services:

1. Can photos of the existing roof finish be shared with the interested bidders.

Response: Yes, Refer to Addendum No. 1 attachment(s).

2. What is the square footage of the existing interior spaces that are to be painted in the CFS Building?

**Response:** Refer to Amendment No. 2 - Revised Bid Schedule line item no. 5. Quantity and Unit Measure includes the square footage for both Interior and Exterior of the CFS Building combined.

3. Will the interior of the building require water blasting prior to painting? If so, is there adequate water drainage within the building?

**Response:** Yes, all interior open spaces require water blasting. Refer to Amendment No. 2 – Revised Bid Schedule line item no. 3.

4. How many access points are there for the water supply? Is water pressure adequate in these areas?

Response: Yes. The Port will provide you with an ample water supply.

5. Does the interior painting of the building include the ceiling?





**Response:** Yes. Including accessible areas with the drop ceiling at the Eastern bays using the same paint for the interior and exterior of the CFS Building. Refer to Amendment No. 2 – Revised Bid Schedule Line item 4.

6. How will any new concrete spalling or crack repair be addressed if it occurs during water blasting/painting?

**Response:** Please provide your unit costs for concrete crack repair per lineal foot and concrete spall repair per cubic foot in order to address the above eventuality. Refer to Amendment No. 2 – Revised Bid Schedule Line item(s) 8 & 9.

7. What is the total number of days allotted for the completion of the project?

Response: A total of One hundred eighty (180) calendar days from the date of NTP (Notice to Proceed).

8. Can this be extended to accommodate the need to get proper security clearances to enter the project site?

Response: Refer to Amendment No. 1

9. How old is the existing roof coating?

Response: There has been minimal coating (only partial). Refer to Addendum No. 1 attachment(s) of the roof.

10. Most of the Port's buildings appear to have flat paint coatings. Is there a reason for wanting to utilize semi-gloss paint?

Response: Refer to Amendment No. 2 – Revised Bid Schedule line item no. 5. We need a more durable paint against a nearby source of moisture and salt spray.

11. Can the Port entertain a request to extend the bid deadline an additional 3 weeks, to August 22, 2022, for bidders to contact suppliers and bonding companies? to determine the availability of products and supplies needed for the project and to adjust/revise bids based on the responses from the Port to all the questions posed.


