- 4. In reference to RFI response on Q6-A, please confirm that vendor can provide an 8 or 16 port switch if meets the needs of location.
 - Response: Minimum of 16 port switches required to accommodate future expansions.
- 4. In reference to Q6-A, please advise if vendor can provide an 8, 16, or 24 port switches with 2 SFP ports. Response: 2 SFP ports switch is acceptable as long as it has a minimum of 16TP (twister pair) ports.
- In reference to Q25, please confirm that PAG will provide fiber pairs for vendor.
 Response: PAG will provide the spare fiber pairs on each location as long as it exists on the current PAG fiber layout.
- In reference to Q7-B, please confirm if PAG will provide spaces to install network racks.
 Response: PAG will provide the spaces to install network racks but will need Facility's approval per location.
- 7. Based on the new information received in Addendum 1, there are three (3) buildings that are not part of PAG's fiber ring, can we request a site visit to these buildings (Gate House, Lower Tower, Main Gate)? Response: Lower Tower and old gate house is part of the ring. New gate house (gate booths) and main gate is not.
- 8. Requesting for an extension for the bid submittal, pending request for 2nd site visit on Gate House, Lower Tower, Main Gate, and for responses to above.

Question received via e-mail on November 28, 2022 by IT&E

- Referring to GTA's question number 7.C, please confirm if PAG requires transport to be fully
 underground and protected. With PAG's response YES, IT&E follow up question is, will PAG accept
 an air fiber solution pending installation of underground fiber based on deadline?
 Response: It may be considered if it is a commonly used viable commercial solution, but not if it will
 affect the Port's signal on same frequency such as Wifi connectivity in the Yard and Admin. Building.
- 2. If the vendor is offering a non-hosted solution, will the vendor be responsible for providing PRI and/or SIP Trunks to support voice landline?
 - Response: Yes, vendor will be responsible for the PRI/SIP trunks to support the voice landline.
- 3. IT&E is requesting an extension on submission for PAG IFB-003-023. Response: See Amendment 5

Question Received via e-mail on November 28, 2022 by Pacific Data Systems

- 1. Amendment # 3 was missing pages for the listing of phone assignments per location. This created ambiguity in the count of VOIP extensions and POTS lines.
 - Response: Listing of Phone Assignments per Location attached
- 2. PAG revised the Communications portion of the bid specifications. However, PAG did not specify the other end of the fiber connection. Is PAG going to provide the Ethernet switch(es) and SFPs for connections to the head end/main server?
 - Response: Ethernet switches along with the SFP's needed and fiber patch cords shall be provided by the vendor
- 3. PDS requested clarification for the requirement on Page 34 of the IFB, "accommodate relocation of phones upon request" in its initial questions and concerns (Question 9), but this question was not addressed in the addendum. Is this requirement for the term of the contract or only during the installation phase?
 - Response: The requirement is for the duration of the contract.
- 4. PAG amended the delivery/installation timeline from delivery is required within 30 days of order and installation completion within 30 days of system delivery TO "Delivery is required within 90 days of order with completion of system delivery". The wording of this amendment is ambiguous. Please clarify the timelines for delivery of the system and the installation phase including required installation of communications wiring specified. PAG also added the requirement of an additional drop per VOIP extension which requires additional time accommodations to accomplish.

 Response: The delivery of the order amended is 90 days. 45 days for the order and 45 days for the
 - Response: The delivery of the order amended is 90 days, 45 days for the order and 45 days for the installation, or 40 days for the order and 50 days for installation.
- 5. PAG added an additional Ethernet Drop requirement in the last amendment but did not modify the acceptable use of existing CAT3 wiring for the system. PDS believes that use of the existing CAT3 wiring should be removed from the specifications in order to eliminate any confusion regarding the type of communications wiring to be used with the new system. Using both CAT3 and CAT6 wiring for the new VOIP System would significantly complicate the configuration and operation of the new system.
 - Response: New wiring should be used for the new VOIP system. Cat5e/CAT6 should be used for the VOIP extensions while CAT3 or CAT5e/CAT6 can be used for the POTS
- 6. The link PAG provided for download was blank and PDS had to take extra steps to obtain the file via the secondary option of going to PAG and copying it to a USB media. This caused a delay in evaluating PAG's responses.
 - Response: The Port shall allow an extension to all bidders for such inconvenience PAG may have caused due to the inaccessible file due to link or file size.
