

ADDENDUM 1 - QUESTIONS, CONCERNS, AND RESPONSES

Please see below questions submitted by Prospective Bidder (s):

M-80 Systems, Inc.

Question: IFBPAG-004-23 packet notates a preference for Service-Disabled Veteran Owned Business. Will the preference for Women-Owned Small Business, Public Law 36-26 – “Women in Business Act of 2021” also apply? Please advise.

PAG Response: Please refer to IFB-PAG-004-23, Amendment No.1.

Hanssem LLC.

Question: Is this Bid consider to be equal or equivalent to the Cubicle specifications.

PAG Response: This bid is equal or better. Dimensions must meet the minimum requirement.

Question: Please advised if the products procured are to be “US made” or will other area such as “Korea made” be acceptable.

PAG Response: The product offered must be made in the USA. Please refer to page 31 of the IFB, Bid Specifications.

Question: Regarding to Workstation height, please advise if a height of 65”H or 67”H will be acceptable.

PAG Response: The height must be as specified 65”. Please refer to page 31 of the IFB, Bid Specifications.

JMI Edison

Question: May we request for the site visit? This is to help us assess the site since your IFB requires onsite Installation.

PAG Response: The site visit was scheduled on the advertisement and registered bidders attended. Unfortunately, another site visit for a single bidder would be an unreasonable accommodation.

Question: Your deadline to submit all questions and concerns will be tomorrow, Jan. 19, 2023. May we request for the extension to submit questions and concerns to move to Jan. 26? Due to site visit request, we may have concerns that we need to address after the site visit.

PAG Response: The request to schedule a 2nd site visit has been denied. Therefore, to be fair to all bidders, no change on the deadline for Questions and Concerns.

Question: With our experience on supplying the workstations, the manufacturers lead time is 120 to

160 days. Considering the supply chain global problems after the Pandemic. May we request to extend your delivery requirement from 12 to 18 weeks to 20 to 22 weeks?

PAG Response: The extension of the delivery requirement of 20-22 weeks is not acceptable. However, PAG will extend the delivery requirement from 8 – 12 weeks to 10 weeks – 15 weeks.
